SAFEGUARDING ISSUES

- 1. It has come to our attention that some parent/carers are allowing their younger children to come into the school grounds independently in the mornings. We strongly recommend that parent/carers accompany their children onto the school grounds and carefully supervise them, ensuring that they are safely in their class line when staff assume responsibility for them at 8.50am. Pupils in Year 5 and Year 6 are permitted to come into school independently providing parent/carers have completed the relevant authorisation form. Sunshine Club is available for a nominal charge every morning for those parent/carers who cannot wait and supervise their own children until 8.50am.
- 2. The car park in front of the school must only be used by authorised vehicles. It must also not be used as a pedestrian access. Access to the Nursery should only be via the pedestrian access. We are very concerned that parent/carers are putting their children and themselves at huge risk by walking through the car park.

<u>School Arrivals</u>

Please do everything you can to ensure that your child arrives to school on time. It is unsettling for your child to arrive into his/ her classroom late and it is important to get him/her into good habits for later life. If there is anything we can do to help your child's punctuality to improve then please do not hesitate to ask. Please also remember if you arrive and the school playground is empty that you must accompany your child to the main school entrance.

SCHOOL PARKING

Can we please ask that parent/ carers park <u>SAFELY</u> and <u>LEGALLY</u> at all times. Please be considerate to our neighbours by not blocking their access nor parking on pavements

BICYCLE STORAGE AREA

There is a limited storage area for bicycles just to the side of the quad area. Bicycles are left here at their owner's risk and we strongly recommend that they are secured with a lock when left. Anyone wishing to use this facility should contact the school office.

<u>Absences</u>

It is essential that if your child is absent from school you telephone the school office giving the reason for the absence. Please note that specific details are required and reporting him/ her as just "unwell" is not sufficient.

If your child is suffering from sickness or has diarrhoea, <u>it</u> <u>must be 48hrs</u> from the last episode before they return to school.

Packed Lunches

Can we again please ask parent / carers to ensure that their children bring to school a packed lunch with <u>healthy</u> choices in. (No products containing nuts) Items must be able to be opened independently as some children are having to wait a long time for staff to open cartons etc. Please remember no fizzy drinks and plastic bottles/containers only for drinks.

SUN SAFETY

On sunny days we strongly advise that your child applies sun cream before coming to school. A hat is also advisable. Your child may wear sunglasses whilst outside but we advise an inexpensive pair; as with all personal property brought into school we cannot take responsibility for any losses or damages.
